The C-STEM GIRL Camps are focused on motivating middle school students entering 7th or 8th grade to learn computing and STEM concepts through a fun and exciting robotics-based curriculum. This leadership camp will enable them to serve as leaders and inspire other young students to gain interest in science and technology.

All GIRL Camps are funded by various sponsors and attendance is **FREE** for camp participants. The camp participants are also eligible for the Girl's Leadership

At the end of the camp, student teams create a multimedia presentation of their creation, including a video to present it to parents and peers.
